## FIRST CHURCH BUILDING COMMITTEE UPDATE

In an effort to keep everyone informed of our progress on the First Church Building Project, here is the latest update:

- the last of the trees needing to be removed were taken down this week;
- the stone work for the retaining wall is almost complete and looks beautiful;
- once the wall is completed, the masons will move to the other side of the building and begin work on the terrace area;
- the first coat of asphalt for the parking area has been put down;
- insulation has been applied to the interior walls and attic;
- the installation for the elevator is nearing completion.

-Wiring and plumbing for a future generator are on track, although the generator itself is not in the budget.

The next FCBC meeting will be held on Thursday, December 6<sup>th</sup> at 4 PM.



**NEW PARISH AND COMMUNITY CENTER - *Capital Campaign Update***

A new Facebook page and the capital campaign page on our website (<http://www.churchofthemessiahwoodshole.org/capital-campaign>) provide information on the campaign's progress, photos of progress on the building, a link to our original campaign video, *Back to Our Future*, and an online donation function.

Our recent "Woods Hole" mailing (based on town property records and thus reaching many far-flung non-residents) produced gratifying results and substantially expanded our number of supporters. We are pleased to report that contributions and pledges as of November 28th now total \$2.155million. We are setting our sights on our stretch goal of \$2.5 million, the full cost of the completed project. We continue our outreach to the community, foundations, and grant sources. With progress at the site ever more visible and exciting, we expect to report continued progress towards our goal.

We welcome your questions and suggestions. We are deeply grateful to all who are supporting this project that is central to effective service to the parish and to providing new opportunities to the wider community.


